#### **Environmental Research and Activity**

- 'Living Lab for Sustainable Living'. Between 2008-2018, I researched, designed, built, and have been operating a model for sustainable living (agroecological farm + eco-house). For the past year, the farm has been scientifically studies by me along with food and environment experts. The current pioneering results and conclusion have already been presented in scientific conferences and are to be published as a paper, and most likely in follow-up papers as well.
  - o <u>Agroecological farm</u>: An original method for growing a complete diet (wheat, pulses, oil, vegetables, fruit), on minimum land (750m²), and at

- minimum environmental cost (about 15% of conventional farming).
- Self-built off-grid eco-house: Built of local natural materials, featuring many environmental systems, some of which are highly innovative – greywater, passive cooling, rocket mass heater, solar power, composting toilet, green roof, and more.

The smallholding attracts hundreds of visitors each year, including environmental scholars, architects, agronomists, and more.

- My 2021 book *Way* is a description of the philosophy behind the ecological smallholding. Two academic events dedicated to the book at the <u>Van Leer Institute in Jerusalem</u>, and at the <u>Technion</u> hosted 8 academic specialists discussing its key philosophical themes: ethics (Dr. Noa Naaman); political thought (Dr. Dror Yinon); ecology (Prof. Yohay Carmel); education (Prof. Tali Tal); social and environmental responsibility (Prof. Ohad Nachtomy); planning and architecture (Dr. Or Aleksandrovitz), and literature (Prof. Dror Burstein). The book has also generated more than 20 <u>reviews and articles</u> in the main Israeli media channels.
