## **L. Summary of my Activities and Future Plans**

My academic work revolves around spatial policy: The policy formation processes, the planning process, and the affected people. At present my research is focused on the interface between Information and Communication Technology (ICT) and spatial policy, often labeled the "Smart City".

Thus, my dissertation was concerned with the evolution of the population dispersal plans in Israel, the interest groups involved, their influence on the plans, and the plans' influences on the residents. As a practitioner (Chief planner at The Jewish Agency, Strategic advisor at the Ministry of Housing, and self-employed) I was involved in many neighborhood renewal and regional development projects.

Like other urban planners I became interested in the economic and managerial aspects of education, acknowledging its important role in local and regional development. Specifically, I am interested in the school-management's ability to respond to the needs and preferences of its community.

In recent years I am especially interested in smart cities. Initially in the managerial possibilities derived from the use of ICT, and lately asking who might be marginalised by this intensive use of ICT in urban settings? Focusing mainly on older people and immigrants.

This brought me to the subject of the ethical use of ICT, mainly Artificial Intelligence (AI) applications in urban settings.

I regret to inform you that there are some serious concerns about your paper for which it cannot be accepted for publication in Behaviour & Information Technology. However since the reviewers do find some merit in the paper, I would be willing to reconsider if you wish to undertake major revisions and resubmit, addressing the referees' concerns.
