My various academic studies and activities encompass attending the leading law schools and faculties at Haifa University and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, both in Israel, Oxford University in England, Columbia University in the USA, the Munk Center and the University of Toronto, both in Canada, the Max Planck Institute in Germany, and the International Institute of Higher Studies in Criminal Sciences in Italy.

My primary fields of expertise include comparative and international aspects of criminal law and constitutional law, including the mutual relationship between constitutional law and criminal law. My expertise in these fields, both comparatively and internationally, allowed me to expand my areas of research to include, in addition, public international law, the laws of war, terrorism, and the relationship between law and political science, particularly concerning the rule of law, the judiciary, and queries surrounding identities.

Already in my first year of law studies at Haifa University, I found myself fascinated by public law in general and the areas of criminal law and constitutional law in particular. Accordingly, I took every opportunity to join every possible pertinent class and seminar in these subjects at Haifa University and Oxford University (as an exchange student).

Shortly after graduation, I had the honor of clerk for Justice Dalia Dorner at the Supreme Court of Israel. Under her supervision, I realized the intrinsic nexus between constitutional law and various realms of criminal law. I also realized that insofar as constitutional scrutiny is concerned, substantive criminal law, unlike the law of criminal procedures, has not received enough attention, if at all, neither by the judiciary nor academia.

To enrich my knowledge in substantive criminal law, I joined the direct program for doctoral studies at the Hebrew University. I was privileged to learn from leading Israeli experts in this field.

Promptly after accomplishing my course duties at the Hebrew University, I joined Columbia University – first as a student in the Masters in Law program, and then as a doctoral student – thus engaging in thorough research in comparative constitutional law,

comparative criminal law, and other various related topics in international law and international criminal law.

At Columbia University, supervised by the internationally well-known scholar Prof. George P. Fletcher, I dedicated all my academic time and efforts to studying and researching the constitutional aspects of substantive criminal law. My research was highly affected by conceptual and comparative studies.

Following my graduation from Columbia, I felt confident enough to dive into numerous seas of constitutional law and criminal law, thus widening and deepening my research into particular challenging topics that concern the comparative, international, and conceptual aspects of constitutional law, criminal law, and the coloration between both of them.

During my research fellowship at the University of Toronto, I sought to inquire into Canadian jurisprudence concerning constitutional scrutiny over substantive criminal law. Additionally, it was there, in Canada, that I expressed specific concerns in examining constitutional queries regarding Israel's nature as a Jewish and democratic State, thus developing several arguments in favor of reconciling Israel's Jewishness with its democratic features.

Later on, during my post-doctoral studies at the Max Planck Institute, I elaborated on my understanding of the very sophisticated German jurisprudence on the constitutional analysis of the very conceptual principles of substantive criminal law. In addition, I had the privilege to initiate new research in international criminal law by examining unsettled issues in this field in light of my previous research on the constitutional understanding of substantive criminal law principles.

My novel interest in international criminal law led me to join the International Institute of Higher Studies in Criminal Sciences in Italy. As a result, I had the honor of learning from and collaborating with the distinguished expert Prof. Mahmoud Cherif Bassiouni. This precious experience contributed to and elaborated on my fields of research.

The output of all my above-referenced academic studies and activities, covering research, writings, and published articles and books in constitutional law, criminal law, international law, and international criminal law, is fully summarized and documented in

my CV's list of publications. My publications are characterized by a transparent methodology of conceptualism, constitutionalism, and comparative approach throughout all my research.

In addition to all these, upon my return to Israel in 2008, I was fortunate to meet Prof. Amnon Carmi, the first head of the School of Law at Zefat Academic College, where I started my academic teaching career. Prof. Carmi introduced me to medical law and bioethics and invited me to join the International Center for Health, Law, and Ethics at Haifa University, the World Association for Medical Law, and the International Journal of 'Medicine and Law.' In this realm, I have been appointed as Editor-in-Chief of the Journal, published a monograph on *Medical Law in Israel*, an edited and updated version of Prof. Carmi's book on Health and Law and an article on *Reflections on International Medical Law*.
